

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. This portable Sconce has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not attempt to defeat this safety features.
- 2. It is recommended to use 1x40-Watt maximum Type B standard bulb.
- 3. To avoid the risk of fire do not exceed the recommended wattage.
- 4. The manufacturer and distributor accept no liability for incorrect installation.
- 5. For indoor use only.
- 6. Keep away from children.

WARNINGS:

Please read all instructions completely before installation.

TO ASSEMBLE:

- 1. Carefully unpack the Sconce. Do not discard any material till assembly is complete.
- 2. Unscrew the black plate strips from the sconce base.
- 3 Align and screw the back plate strips on the desired wall location.
- 4 Now the place the sconce base on the black plate strips and tighten the screws.
- 4 Place the Shade on to the Sconce and and tighten with shade ring.
- Insert bulbs (not included) into the socket.
 Insert the polarized plug in the outlet & turn on the power, to test the Sconce

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

To clean, use a soft dry cloth only. Donot use any chemical or abrasive cleaners.
